Inducer Motor Replacement Kit

For G8SA 80% ULN 55,000 BTU Single Stage Ultra-Low NOx Furnace

BEFORE STARTING THE REPLACEMENT

When replacing the inducer motor assembly on 80% Ultra-Low NOx models, the following steps should be followed:

1. Set the thermostat to the OFF position or to its lowest setting.

A WARNING:

To avoid electric shock, personal injury, or death, turn off the electric power at the disconnect or the main service panel before making any electrical connections.

- 2. Turn off all electrical power to the appliance.
- 3. Turn OFF gas supply to furnace.

REPLACING INDUCER MOTOR ASSEMBLY

- 1. Loosen the flue pipe from the inducer outlet connector.
- 2. Disconnect the inducer wiring at its quick connect plug assembly and chassis ground.
- 3. Remove the five screws holding the inducer motor assembly to the collector box. See Figure 1.
- 4. Remove the inducer and gasket. Ensure collector pan is free of any old gasket material.
- Mount replacement inducer motor assembly 1039441on the furnace ensuring alignment of the new gasket. The bolts should be tight with inducer not capable of moving. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN**, this could result in stripped out mounting holes.

- 6. Reconnect inducer wiring at quick connect plug and reattach chassis ground.
- 7. Reconnect flue to inducer outlet collar and secure with screws

REPLACING COMBUSTION AIR ORIFICE ON REV. 1 MODELS PRODUCED BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2021.

The new 101874006- 0.94" combustion air orifice plate supplied in this kit must be used with inducer motor 1039941- (on motor NP), in place of current 1.04" diameter plate (101874005-) on older models.

- 1. Remove the two screws attaching the combustion air orifice plate and gasket to the fuel/air mixing tube.
- 2. Replace w/ new gasket when mounting 0.94" orifice plate to mixing tube and secure with two screws.

CHECK THE OPERATION OF THE APPLIANCE

- 1. Turn ON gas supply to furnace. Check for leaks.
- 2. Turn ON all electrical power to the appliance.
- 3. Set the thermostat to the ON position and set 1-2F higher than room to initiate call for heat.
- 4. Follow the Start-Up Procedure as outlined in the G8SA Series installation instructions. Start the furnace to ensure correct pressure switch operation. If the furnace does not fire and a fault code is given by the control board, the inducer bolts may require further tightening. Carefully tighten the bolts slightly more and restart the furnace.
