- 1. Cut off the end of the rod extension at the dimple.
- Install main air limit(s) from old element plate to new element plates. Refer to Figure 1 for main air limit location(s).

For units manufactured before January 1 2024:

 Install covers by screwing in plates over backup limit hole(s). Refer to Figure 1 for main air limit location(s).

For units manufactured after January 1 2024:

 Install backup limit(s) from old element plate to new element plates. Refer to Figure 1 for main air limit location(s).
